How Books are Made

Best for Grades 2nd-6th (45 min)

In this inspiring presentation, Kailei will read one of her books and teach students about how books are made. From initial idea, through *much* rejection and *many* revisions, all the way through printing. Students will learn about perseverance and dedication on the path to making their dreams a reality.

Who's the Monster Here?

Best for Grades Kinder-2nd (30-45 min)

In this unique program, Kailei will read THE MONSTER ABOVE THE BED, lead students in a discussion about perceptions, judgements, and othering, and end with a fun "who's the monster here" game.

Reading, Game, and Q&A

Best for Grades PreK-1st (20-30 min)

In this short presentation perfect for younger and/or more wiggly groups, Kailei will read one of her books, play a game with the kids, and answer any questions.

Kids Can! Invention Challenge

Best for Grades 2nd-6th (45 min)

In this empowering presentation, Kailei will read one section of KID-VENTORS and teach about the stages of invention. Kids will then create participate in an invention demonstration.

Research in Nonfiction

Best for Grades 4th-6th (45 min)

In this informational presentation, Kailei will read one section of KID-VENTORS and teach about the process of researching and writing nonfiction stories. She will cover information about online research, library research, interviews, and more!

Good for All Ages (30-45 min)

In this inspirational presentation, Kailei will read I SEE COLOR and discuss the importance of learning from each other, celebrating diversity, and standing against racism.

Kailei will coordinate all of her own travel.

Schools will receive a simple invoice with one set price.

Full day visits can include up to any 4 presentations, plus "lunch with an author" for a selected small group, and an optional book signing. Choose 4 different presentations or all of the same to different groups throughout the day. Invite Kailei into multiple classrooms, or host larger assemblies. It's your choice to mix and match as you see fit for your school!

*Title I Schools qualify for a \$100 discount

Multi-Day/Group Discounts:

A school that books 2 or more consecutive days, or schools in the same district and/or geographical area that book 2 consecutive days qualify for a discounted rate of \$1200 for "somewhat local" and \$2000 for "beyond."

How to Host a Book Sale at your Visit

Option 1:

Kailei will provide a flyer and order forms to send home with students. A QR code will allow them to order directly from Kailei's local indie bookstore, Literally a Bookshop, without you having to collect money. Books will be shipped directly to your school, already signed and personalized). **For local visits, Kailei will bring the books when she comes, and there will also be an option to pay cash on the day of the visit.**

Option 2:

If you have someone who is willing to do the leg work and collect the money, you can order books at the school discounted price directly through Kailei's publishers. Kailei can still provide an order form for you to send home with students, but you will have to contact the publishers directly for current discounts and information on how to place your final order.

Option 3:

You may choose to work with your own local bookstore and coordinate all sales and orders. Kailei will still provide an order form for this option if you provide her with all of the information and details needed.

***** Please Note: Going with option 2 or 3 means you will need to plan additional time for Kailei to be able to sign the books at the visit and may only be able to include 3 presentations.**

Tips for a Great Author Visit

For the smoothest In-Person Visits, I will need:

- A smart board or projector/screen with HDMI input so that I can use my own computer . If I'll need to use a school computer, please let me know ahead of time so that I can send the presentation to your system.
- Microphone for larger assemblies
- Large floor easel for those requesting the WHO'S THE MONSTER HERE presentation.

Tips to Get Kids Excited for an Author Visit

- Prepare the kids before I come. Get to know a little about me and my books before I come by checking out my website, KaileiPewBooks.com
- Communicate well with Kailei before the event so she knows not only which presentations she'll be giving, but which classrooms she will be working with, how big the groups will be, etc.
- Share any needs with Kailei ahead of time. She loves connecting with kids and wants to make the most of every visit. She's here to help you with any needs you might have.
- Make sure teachers are present for the visit and able to help with classroom management.
- Participate in the book sale. While not a requirement for the visit, it gets kids really excited! There's nothing like getting your own personalized, signed book, directly from the author or illustrator.
- Participate in the "lunch with an author" option. Kailei encourages you to select a diverse group of students, and consider inviting some kids who many not usually get selected for those types of "extras" to come and chat with her over lunch.
- Use the free classroom guides after Kailei visits for follow up activities and discussions.
